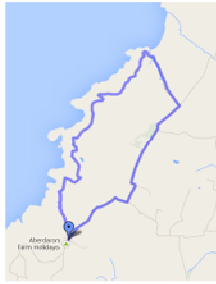


Aberdaron Farm Holidays



Circular Coastal Walk starting from Beudy Mawr and the Bunkhouse

Approx: 3.5 miles

Turn left after leaving the holiday cottage / bunkhouse. Walk down the country road until you come to a junction. Turn left here.



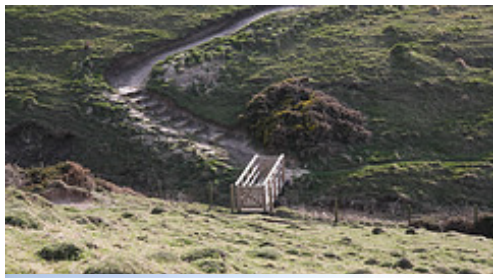
Follow the road until you reach a sign for a National Trust car park at Porthor (Whistling Sands).



Go down the track and through the car park to join the Coastal Path.
(View of Whistling Sands from the coastal path)



Follow the Coastal Path, keeping the sea to your right. (Mynydd Carreg is on your left)



After about a third of a mile, although a path veers leftwards inland, you need to turn down into the valley to cross the stream by a small wooden bridge.



Go up the slope through an area of rough grazing land.



Continue straight ahead until you see Beudy Mawr / the Bunkhouse on your left. Keeping the fence on your right, walk down to the road.



Go over the stile, turn right and Beudy Mawr / the Bunkhouse are just down the lane on your right.
